So, we have decided to call for ideas of “Nerima’s future with agriculture” to promise our great, great, and great grandchildren a bright future.

There are two categories under this “Everyone is a Creator! — Making Our Future City with Agriculture” contest. One is an “Idea (for Paintings)” section, which is for elementary school and junior high-school students, and the other is a “Project Planning” section, which is for everyone. Idea (for Paintings) Section

(For Elementary School and Junior High-School Students)

Introduction:

Let’s suppose, one day, a boy, who insists that he comes from the future suddenly appeared and said;

“Hello. I came from 2040.

What do you think of Nerima City in the future, in my time?

There are more farmlands in Nerima in the future.

How would you like to live in Nerima in 2040?

What makes you happy with the farmlands in the future?

Please think about it and draw your idea of how Nerima with the farmlands will become in 2040.

If you draw it, then I will bring it to 2040 and show it to you in 2040.

I promise.”

So, what do you think of Nerima City and Nerima’s farmlands will be in 2040?

Do you think what kind of food is grown in Nerima’s farmlands in 2040, or, something other than “food” might be also grown in the farmlands in the future??? Or, even the farmlands would not be on the ground in 2040, instead, they are flying or swimming??? You can be free and creative! Tell us about your unique ideas of Nerima’s future and farmlands with your paintings and words! Your idea might change Nerima’s future!

Eligibility: Elementary School/ Junior High-School Students

*Individual and/or group applications are accepted.

*Multiple applications from one individual, one group, or both individual and group are accepted.

* The winners shall be able to participate in the Awarding Ceremony, planning to be held on November 24, 2018 at Coconeri Industrial Event Center, Nerima City.

Theme: "The Future of Nerima City with Agriculture — 20 years from now"

*Expressing your idea of "The Future of Nerima City with Agriculture — 20 years from now" with a painting (with watercolors, crayons, colored pencils, markers, or any other drawing medium) and words (approx. 100 words).

Submissions:

① Painting(s)/ Drawing paper with the size of 38.2 cm × 27.1 cm and using watercolors, crayons, colored pencils, markers, or any other drawing medium.

*Multiple entry is welcomed. If you have many ideas, then you can submit all!

② Application Form/ Filling out the Application Form (attached at the end of these application guidelines), including the description of your idea (approx. 100 words).

*Please attach the Application Form (with the description) to the back side of the painting so that the Application Form and the painting will not be separated.

*If you are applying for more than one painting, then please attach one Application Form (with the description) to each painting.

Application Deadline: Friday, September 7, 2018

*Your work and Application Form **must be arrived** at the Office of Urban Agriculture World Summit **by Sept. 7th, 2018.**

Mail the above two submissions (① Painting(s) and ② Application form(s) with the description) to the Office Urban Agriculture World Summit Committee by the deadline (September 7th, 2018 *Must be arrived at the Office of UAWS.), or you can also apply through your school.

Result Notification:

We will notify the results **ONLY** to the winners with a letter **by the end of October, 2018.**

Returning Policy:

All applied paintings will be preserved by Nerima City Office till 2040 and will be announced in the Nerima City newsletter in 2040. You can meet your ideas of Nerima's future, which you created when you were 22 years younger than how old you are in 2040! In 2040, does your idea close to what you imagined 22 years ago?

After the announcement in the Nerima City newsletter in 2040, the applicants will be able to request Nerima City Office for returning the paintings.

*Without requests, the submitted paintings may not be able to return to the applicants.

Terms and Conditions:

Please read carefully through the following “Terms and Conditions” and sign the Application Form with your agreement in order to apply. If the applicant is under 20 years old at the time to apply, then his/her guardian shall agree to the “Terms and Conditions” and sign the Application Form. (*Since the “Idea (for Paintings)” Section is for elementary school and junior high-school students, the applicant’s guardian shall agree to the “Terms and Conditions” and sign the Application Form.)

- Be able to attend the Awarding Ceremony , planning to be held on November 24th, 2018 at Coconeri Industrial Event Center, Nerima City when the applied paintings win the Excellence Award.
- Be able to agree to announce the applied painting, description of the painting, name, school name, and grade on the website and other medias.
- Be able to agree to announce the digital contents of the applied painting, description of the painting, and name on the website and other medias in 2040.
- Be able to agree to the returning policy.
- The applied paintings must be originally created by the applicants and unpublished inside and/or outside Japan.
- The applied paintings must not infringe copyright, trademark, patent or other intellectual property, or shall not facilitate the unlawful distribution of copyrighted content or illegal content.
- Copyright, intellectual property rights and all content of the submitted works are owned by the organizer (including the rights prescribed in Article 27 and 28 of the copyright law), and the organizer can use the submitted works to promote the “Urban Agriculture World Summit” without any compensation.
- After the “Urban Agriculture World Summit Committee” is dissolved, Nerima City Office will inherit the copyright intellectual property rights and all content of the submitted works.
- Do not apply the submitted work for other contests and/or competitions, besides this “Everyone is a Creator! — Making Our Future City with Agriculture” Contest.
- The applicants shall bear the expenses required for the submissions. The organizer does not owe any responsibilities for the damages caused by sending and handling.
- When an arrangement arises other than the items stated in the “Terms and Conditions”, the organizer can make the judgement to decide. When the applicant does not agree to the organizer’s decision, he/she can withdraw the submission. In this case, the applicant shall bear the expenses required for cancelling the submission as well as for the returning the

submitted work.

- When it is found that the applicant is in breach of the “Terms and Conditions,” the organizer is eligible for invalidating the application. When the violation is found after receiving the prize, the organizer is eligible for cancelling the prize and making the prize return to the organizer. The organizer is not responsible for the expenses for the shipping to return the prize and any compensation of damages caused by the cancelation of the prize.
