

Rules for Recyclables and Waste Collection

1. Please separate Recyclables, Combustible (Burnable) and Incombustible (Non-burnable) Wastes. If separation is not correct, the wastes will not be collected.
2. Please send the wastes out to the collection point by 8 a.m., and bottles, cans and pet-bottles by 9 a.m. (Collection time varies at collaborating stores. Consult each store for operating hours.)
3. Please do not leave the items other than Recyclables and Wastes around collection point.

- Please disassemble and separate burnable portion (cloth, plastics and others) from metal portion as much as possible, in case of a mixture of burnable and metal materials.
 - Sharp-edged objects such as skewer should be wrapped with paper or alike and marked as "dangerous."
 - The contents of lighters and spray cans, etc. should be emptied before disposing. ***It may cause fire on garbage collection car.**

 - Please remove plastic portion from paper from a mixed product such as envelope with window and tissue paper box. (Plastics go to combustible wastes).

1. Remove the lid.

1. Rinse lightly with and drain off the water.

*Metal lids are to go to incombustible wastes.

2. Rinse lightly with water and drain off the water.

2. Lightly crush the cans for beverages.

- The collection is not made for bottles and cans unemptied, dirty, or with oil or chemicals remaining inside.

In the collection morning, please place them quietly into the net container bag supplied by the city.

- Please have them in a washed or cleaned state.
 - Please put them in a highly transparent bag before disposal.

Please bring out to the designated collection point at the specified time. (A collection vehicle will be waiting.)
