For Foreign Residents Notice about the Basic Resident Registration Network System

For foreign residents, who are registered in Residence Record, the Basic Resident Registration Network System (Jyuki Net System) will commence operation on July 8, 2013.

★ What is the Basic Resident Registration Network System?

The Basic Resident Registration Network System is a system that enables identity verification at any public agencies throughout Japan by putting the basic information such as address, name, sex and birthdate on a nationwide network of national and local government.

★A Resident Record Code

To secure the nation-wide identity verification by the System, 11 digit number (a Resident Record Code) will be attached to each resident.

★Dispatch of a Notification of a Resident Record Code

Your Resident Record Code will be entered on a Residence Card of a municipality where you registered your residence, and the notice will be dispatched to you as from July 8, 2013.

★On the receipt of the Notification of a Resident Record Code

- O Please keep the notification carefully
- O No procedures are necessary to be taken.

★ Nation-wide issuance of a copy of Residence Record

(%The copy of Residence Record issued in the city where you live in and that issued out of the city (nation-wide issuance version) certifies different items.)

In accordance with the commencement of operation of the Basic Resident Registration Network System, "a copy of Residence Record" will be issued at any municipalities in Japan as of July 8, 2013.

★The Basic Resident Registration Card

With the start of the operation of the Basic Resident Registration Network System, the Basic Resident Registration Card(Juki Card) will be issued for foreign residents as well on request.(chargeable) If you have registered your alias to the Residence Record, it will be entered to the Basic Resident Registration Card as well.

(%You are not obliged to request Juki Card if not necessary.)

★Use of the Basic Resident Registration Network System

The use of the Basic Resident Registration Network System is limited only to Japanese public organizations and when it is used in accordance with provisions. Any private organizations are not allowed its use for any purposes because it is not legally stipulated.
